1. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Tracy Pribbenow called the meeting to order at 7:30pm

2. CONSENT AGENDA

Toyia Bulla moved to approve the minutes from January 27th, 2022 & January 31st, 2022, seconded by Reba Lee, passed 5-0.

4. OLD BUSINESS

1. Department Reports

A. Public Works – Darren Woodson presented that the culvert on Eagle will be getting replaced next week depending on the weather. Dan Bliss presented a meter lids quote from Salina Supply Co.; replacements are needed due to residents breaking them, and one resident has broken theirs twice by running over it. Dan Bliss did have the resident pay for the replacement at the cost of \$40.00. Toyia Bulla stated that no motion needs made to order the lids since it is under the \$500.00 requirement for approval. James Roberts will get with Public Works on reviewing and updating the spreadsheet of outstanding projects.

B. Fire Department – Chief Jeremy Lee presented a report that a few fire department volunteers are attending a EMT class at Butler CC. Chief Jeremy Lee also said that he is paying for a training class out of pocket at a cost of \$400.00 which will send 3 members to the “Into the Job” Firefighters Symposium in Wichita, August 12th – 13th, 2022. Tracy Pribbenow and Toyia Bulla stated that if he can get a receipt for the cost he can be reimbursed from the training budget. Reba Lee motioned to approve the MES air pack service and certification cost, seconded by Toyia Bulla, passed 5-0.

C. Police Department – Chief Tim Bryan presented his report that reserve officer Michael Haas is going to attend a training class to become a part time Officer to be able to get paid and insured. Chief Tim Bryan stated that the Flock camera is in operation thanks to Dan Bliss and Darren Woodson to help set it up. Chief Tim Bryan said he got a call this morning from the State Agencies in the partnership agreement to look at the data for high interest targets. Chief Tim Bryan said that Sedgwick County just hired about 15 new deputies. Chief Tim Bryan also stated that the road closing at Midland between Davidson Ave and Wichita Ave is needing to be reviewed for the purpose of either making it permanent to block during business hours or extend it again. Chief Tim Bryan said that Tamara Roberts has been doing a good job with written letters for collecting outstanding court payments, and also communicating with him on cases.

D. Park & Recreation – Reba Lee presented that the basketball goal is up at the park with the help of Dan Bliss and a few others. Reba Lee is in the process of getting the bids for 2022 projects. Toyia Bulla would like for Reba Lee to get a breakout of line items for her budget to Tamara Roberts to work on setting them up in the General Ledger.

2. Outstanding Items Report Update – Toyia Bulla said to remove old items and update with new items.

5. NEW BUSINESS

A. Tracy Pribbenow presented that Waste Connections rate is increasing on April 1st, 2022 by .15 cents per trash can and recycle bin. Tracy Pribbenow would like to see how long our contract is with them. Tracy Pribbenow would like to get new bids for service, Brad Jantz will look into the contract and present it at next council meeting.

B. Tracy Pribbenow would like to have a budget list presented quarterly.

C. Chris Chippeaux stated that they closed on the lots and will bring bids for the survey to extend the road of Devonshire Ave all the way up to Macy.

D. Tracy Pribbenow stated that there is a training for LKM in Manhattan, Ks April 29th and 30th, 2022 for newly elected members. Council members who are interested in attending should get with her to get registered.
